As we begin a new school year, we would like to inform you that our school continues to participate in “We Share the Air”, a scent sensitivity awareness campaign. There are students attending this school who suffer from potentially life-threatening asthmatic conditions triggered by air pollutants. **Exposure even to minimal odours may cause potentially life-threatening reactions.**

Very common severe chemical triggers are perfume, cologne, scented products, and personal care products (such as hairspray). These products may cause severe reactions for students. The safety and well-being of all our students is a priority.

To ensure the safety and well-being of all students, please refrain from wearing scented personal products complying with our Scent Free Zone campaign at school and all school events. Please ensure that all caregivers are also aware of this campaign.
